M3M Foundation drives a holistic development mission through nine flagship programmes that collectively empower communities across education, livelihood, health, and environment. **iMpower** is a transformative initiative for construction and migrant workers' families—creating learning hubs, health linkages, digital literacy, and women's empowerment clubs within worker settlements. Extending the chain of learning, **Saakshar** ensures quality education for all through scholarships, digital learning labs, school infrastructure upgrades, teacher training, and the unique Buniyaad initiative—promising education for a girl child with every home sold. **Kaushal Sambal** strengthens employability and entrepreneurship through certified training in technical trades, hospitality, and beauty sectors, alongside mentorship and placement linkages that build pathways to self-reliance. **Lakshya** nurtures sports and performing arts talent from underprivileged communities through financial aid, advanced training, and performance support—enabling youth to excel on national and international platforms. **Mashaal** fuels the spirit of changemaking by supporting social innovators and youth leaders with fellowships, mentorship, and seed funding to accelerate SDG-aligned community solutions. On the humanitarian front, **Kartavya** embodies compassion through Poshan nutrition drives, *Lala Ji Ki Rasoi* community kitchens, Sahyog worker welfare, Share for Care blanket drives, and health & eye camps. Environmental commitment shines through **Sankalp**, promoting tree plantations, natural farming, water conservation, and biodiversity awareness, while **Sarvodaya** uplifts rural India through village-level development plans focusing on health, education, solar energy, and livelihoods. Completing the ecosystem, **Van Jeevan** champions wildlife conservation and human-animal coexistence. Together, these nine programmes embody M3M Foundation's mission of **“Transforming Lives, Building a Nation.”**





# iMpower



During the quarter, the iMpower Programme by M3M Foundation continued to strengthen access to education, leadership development, and community awareness among children and underserved communities through structured engagement and creative platforms.



## Tarang 2.0,

held from 3–9 October 2025 at AIFACS, New Delhi, provided children from migrant communities with a public platform to showcase their artistic talent. The exhibition celebrated their creativity and aspirations, reinforcing art as a medium for confidence and expression.



On 29 November 2025, under **MAD About Health**, 80 children participated in an interactive exposure visit to Shree Ram Millennium School, engaging in creative and well-being activities that promoted learning and confidence beyond the classroom.

In Kangra district, Himachal Pradesh, the programme advanced community leadership and gender equity across **30 Gram Panchayats** through capacity-building sessions and exposure visits, strengthening grassroots decision-making and collective action.



The **Mobile Resource Centre (e-Rickshaw)** continued delivering foundational literacy, numeracy, and life-skills education directly at construction sites and underserved locations, bridging learning gaps for children outside the formal schooling system.



## Empowering young minds. Enabling brighter futures.

iMpower Club students also staged a **nukkad natak on child marriage**, raising awareness on child protection and the importance of continued education. The performance encouraged community dialogue and positioned children as advocates for social change.



These initiatives reflect iMpower's continued commitment to building inclusive learning environments, strengthening community leadership, and enabling children to thrive with confidence and dignity.

# Kartavya



During the quarter, the Kartavya Programme by M3M Foundation continued to strengthen worker welfare across construction sites by improving access to healthcare, nutrition, and essential support services for workers and their families.



To promote preventive healthcare, **31 health camps** were organised across multiple construction sites, **benefiting 4,980 workers** with medical consultations, diagnostic screenings, and free medicines.

The camps provided essential services including **blood pressure, blood sugar, haemoglobin testing, eye and dental screenings**, helping address health concerns among migrant and daily wage workers.



Strengthening community health awareness, a blood donation camp was organised where **133 blood units were collected**.

The initiative also included **301 HIV tests, 240 blood pressure screenings, 153 haemoglobin tests, and 173 eye check-ups**, reinforcing the programme's focus on preventive and accessible healthcare.

Nutrition support remained a key pillar of the programme through the **POSHAN initiative**, under which **23,29,825 nutritious meals** were distributed during the quarter, ensuring improved nutrition and well-being for workers across construction sites.



Community solidarity was further strengthened through a Bhandara organised on 16 October 2025, celebrating six years of M3M Foundation.



The initiative brought together **27,570 workers and community members**, fostering a sense of belonging and appreciation within the workforce.

As part of seasonal welfare support, the **Share for Care** winter initiative distributed **25,271 winter jackets** to labour beneficiaries, helping workers cope with harsh winter conditions while ensuring dignity and safety at worksites.



In addition, under the Payal @40 initiative, a **Tetanus (TT) vaccination drive** was conducted across two construction sites, **benefiting 150+ workers** and reinforcing the importance of preventive healthcare.



*These initiatives reflect Kartavya's continued commitment to ensuring the well-being, dignity, and safety of construction workers while strengthening community support systems at the grassroots.*

# Vanjeevan



During the quarter, the Vanjeevan programme by M3M Foundation continued to promote sustainable livelihoods and environmental conservation across ecologically sensitive regions.

Awareness generation remained a key focus, with **nukkad nataks** conducted across **86 villages in Pilibhit**, engaging over **14,500 community members**, including **53% women**, on conservation and responsible resource use.



The programme also strengthened livelihood opportunities, enabling women to generate **₹4 lakh through hyacinth-based handicrafts (31 beneficiaries)** and **₹1 lakh through honey production (16 women from 4 SHGs)**.



In addition, solar-powered water solutions were implemented to support wildlife and ecosystems, providing 72,000 litres of water daily in **Tipeshwar Wildlife Sanctuary (Maharashtra)** and 24,000 litres daily in **Kolhuchaur Forest Reserve (Uttarakhand)**.



# Sankalp



During the quarter, the Sankalp programme by M3M Foundation strengthened its efforts towards water conservation and climate-resilient community development in the Tauru block of Nuh district.

A key milestone included the initiation of a **wastewater treatment system** in Hasanpur village, with a capacity to treat over **6 million litres annually** using natural filtration methods.



Community engagement remained central, with **31 Jal Samwad meetings** reaching **300 participants (195 women)** and a **Kisan Jagruti Shivar** engaging **130 farmers**, promoting awareness on water conservation and sustainable practices.

To address water accessibility challenges, **8 water storage tanks (17,000 litres each)** are being constructed, **benefiting 32 families** and enhancing local water security. Additionally, **sprinklers were provided to 30 farmers** to promote water-efficient agriculture.



The programme also initiated **blue-green climate-resilient infrastructure** in collaboration with **Navjyoti India Foundation** at Civil Lines Police Station, Gurugram, addressing urban waterlogging challenges.



# Lakshya



During the quarter, the Lakshya Programme by M3M Foundation continued to strengthen India's emerging sporting talent through structured training, exposure, and recognition platforms, enabling young athletes to move closer to national and international excellence.



The flagship initiative **"VIJAY BHAV - MITTI SE MEDAL TAK"** was launched in the presence of eminent dignitaries including the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana, the State Sports Minister, Ms. P.T. Usha, and Olympian Yogeshwar Dutt. The initiative aims to prepare young athletes for the **Asian Youth Games 2025**, inspiring them through mentorship, motivation, and structured sporting pathways.



The programme advanced girls' empowerment through **VEERANGNA**, a joint initiative with ABVP Gurugram Mahanagar, marked by a large self-defence mega demonstration on Stree Shakti Diwas. Graced by senior dignitaries, the initiative is training 3,000 girls from 30 Gurugram schools in self-defence, cyber safety, first aid, and wellness—strengthening confidence, preparedness, and safety awareness.

To encourage grassroots participation, the Foundation supported **M.P. KHEL MAHOTSAV 2025** by distributing **nearly 15,000 tracksuits** to participating athletes, ensuring access to proper sports gear.

# Mashaal



During the quarter, the MASHAAL programme by M3M Foundation advanced its focus on environmental sustainability through the Green Classroom Project in Nuh district, Haryana.



The **Green Classroom Project** was implemented across **10 government schools**, engaging students and teachers through a structured, multi-phase approach.



With **30+ awareness sessions**, the programme addressed key themes such as waste management, water conservation, and sustainable practices, encouraging responsible environmental behaviour.

Through **interactive activities** and **waste collection drives**, students were actively involved in experiential learning, while teacher training sessions strengthened the integration of environmental education within classrooms.



# Saakshar



During the quarter, the SAAKSHAR Scholarship Programme by M3M Foundation continued to expand access to education for students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, enabling them to pursue their academic aspirations with confidence and continuity.

With **828 active beneficiaries** across **21 States and Union Territories**, the programme strengthened its nationwide outreach while maintaining a strong focus on equity and inclusion, with **54% female beneficiaries**.



The programme also recorded a measurable academic impact, with average performance improving to **76% post-scholarship**, reaffirming the role of financial assistance in enhancing learning outcomes.

Continued engagement with partner institutions, communities, and referral networks ensured transparent beneficiary identification and timely support, particularly across **Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, and Delhi NCR**.



# Sarvodaya



During the quarter, the Sarvodaya programme by M3M Foundation continued to drive integrated rural development in the Tauru block of Nuh district, advancing community well-being through focused efforts in education, healthcare, and environmental sustainability.



Under the education component, Balika Manch sessions engaged over **500+ adolescent girls** across multiple villages, creating safe spaces to discuss health, hygiene, and leadership.

The **Satragi Vatika Initiative** was implemented across **15+ government schools**, promoting experiential learning through school-based green spaces and environmental stewardship.



Healthcare outreach under the **Sarvoday Swasth Yatra** saw **10 health camps** conducted across villages including Tauru, Bawla, Sunari, Dulawat, Sundh, Padheni, and Nainangla, benefiting **1,200+ community members** through health screenings and consultations.

In addition, awareness sessions reached **over 800+ villagers**, strengthening knowledge around preventive healthcare, hygiene, and nutrition.



Environmental initiatives focused on sustainable practices, with water management awareness sessions reaching **300+ farmers and community members**.

The programme also promoted kitchen gardens, with mustard seeds distributed to **400+ households**, supporting nutrition and self-reliance.



**Farmer's Day celebrations** encouraged knowledge sharing on improved agricultural practices, while recognising the vital contributions of farmers. The event was graced by **Dr. Shyam Sunder, Block Agriculture Officer**, as the **Chief Guest**.

*Through these efforts, Sarvodaya continues to strengthen grassroots awareness and build resilient, self-reliant rural communities.*

# Kaushal Sambhal



During the quarter, the Kaushal Sambhal Programme by M3M Foundation continued to strengthen livelihood opportunities for youth through industry-aligned skill development, practical exposure, and employment pathways.



A key highlight was the **industrial exposure visit to Cement Expo 2025**, Delhi, where trainees gained practical insights into modern construction technologies and sustainable practices, strengthening their industry readiness.



Extending its impact to underserved regions, M3M Foundation supported **four government schools in the LoC region, District Poonch**, by providing classroom furniture, digital learning tools, solar lighting, and sports kits, benefiting 2,000+ stakeholders.

Conducted in the presence of Major General Kaushik Mukherjee (Sena Medal), Indian Army, the initiative enhanced learning environments in high-risk border areas.

The Foundation also strengthened its skilling ecosystem through an **MoU with Times Foundation**, aiming to **train 900 youth in BFSI, IT/ITeS, and Retail**, with a focus on employability and placement-linked outcomes.



Additionally, its **partnership with ABWCI** is enabling rural women entrepreneurs through capacity building, financial literacy, and market linkages, fostering sustainable livelihoods and economic independence.

Today, Pinki runs a growing enterprise, selling high-quality cold-pressed mustard oil and contributing steadily to her family’s income. Beyond financial stability, her journey has strengthened her confidence and independence, inspiring pride within her family and community. As her family shares, “We are happy and proud that our daughter-in-law is doing meaningful work and supporting the family through her own efforts.” Pinki’s story reflects how skill development and access to the right resources can transform rural women into confident entrepreneurs and community changemakers.

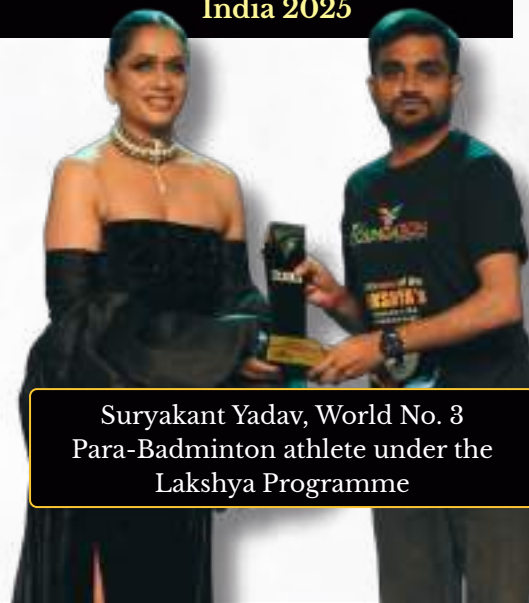
